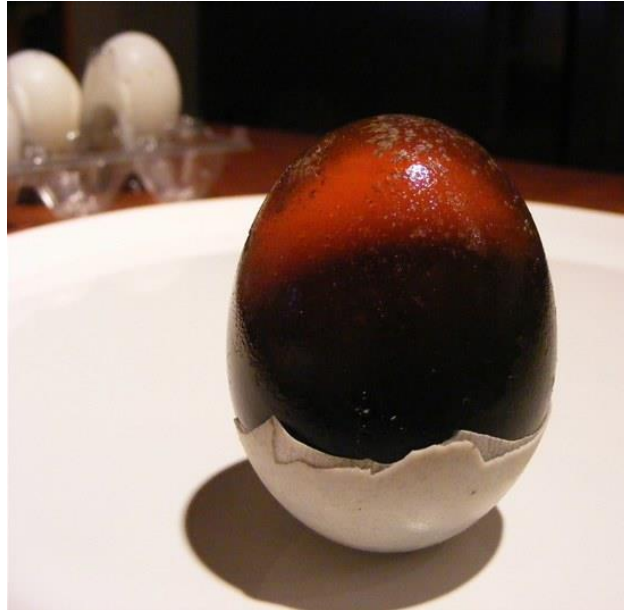

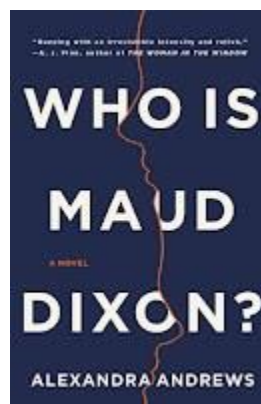
SAFETY AND UPKEEP TIP



If you smell gas (smells like sulphur or rotten eggs) or suspect a gas leak, open a nearby window for ventilation and leave your apartment immediately. Close all doors behind you. Call 9-1-1 and alert building staff to the possible gas leak. Don't return to your unit until the Fire Department or Washington Gas personnel have given the okay.

Friendship Heights Village Center
